VOTING INSTRUCTIONS FOR IMAGE CAST PRECINCT 2

Here is some basic information for you, the voter. If you have any questions after reading this, or at any time during the voting process, ask the town clerk or another election official.

CHECK-IN

- 1. Go to "ENTRANCE" check-in table.
- 2. Give your name and residence to the election official in a loud, clear voice.
- 3. Wait until your name is repeated and checked off by the official.

ENTER

- 1. Enter within the guardrail and do not leave until you have voted.
- 2. An election official will hand you a ballot.
- 3. Go to a vacant booth.

MARK YOUR BALLOT

- 1. Fill in the oval to the right of the name of the candidate(s)/issue(s) you want to vote for.
- 2. WRITE-IN. To vote for someone whose name is not printed on the ballot, use the blank "write-in" lines on the ballot.
- 3. Your ballot will be counted by a computer. DO BEND OR DAMAGE the ballot.

NOTICE TO VOTERS - Instructions for marking your ballot

Make sure that you only fill in an oval for **NO MORE THAN** the "VOTE FOR NOT MORE THAN #" that is printed for each race.

Example 1:	
VOTE FOR NOT MORE	THAN ONE:
Tom Jones	•
Joseph Smith	0

Example 2:		
VOTE FOR NOT MORE THAN TWO:		
Jane Doe	•

Joseph Smith	•	

For example, for statewide offices, you can only vote for one candidate in each race. In some Senate Districts and Representative Districts, you may vote for 2, 3 or 6 candidates. Do not vote for more candidates than allowed in each race. If you vote for more than the allowed number, your vote will not count!
